

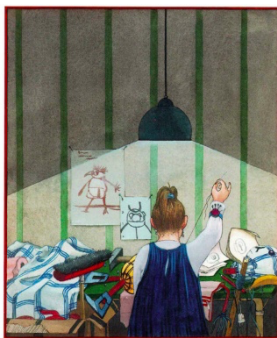


Gerda und Heinz by Nikolaus Heidelbach

She crafted herself a little man and called him Heinz.



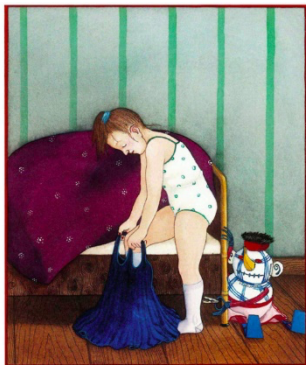
Because she had put in great effort, Heinz was very handsome and could even laugh.
